Hacienda Heights Los Angeles County Public Works Projects

Completed:

Walbrook Drive Et Al - Pavement Preservation Project

7th Street Avenue Parking – Pavement Resurfacing

Hacienda Boulevard from 60 Fwy to Halliburton – Pavement Resurfacing

Hacienda Boulevard at Newton St – upgrade traffic signal

Denley Street between Kwis and end of cul-de-sac and Kwis Avenue south of Denley Street to Binney Street - Installation of 6 streetlights on wood poles

Los Molinos south of Rio Claro Drive to end of cul-de-sac – Installation of 5 streetlights on wood poles

Planted 164 Street Trees at various locations

Future:

Leticia Dr et al. – Pavement Reconstruction is tentatively scheduled for Spring 2021

Garo St et al. – Pavement Reconstruction is tentatively scheduled for early 2020

Colima enhancement project. - Construction is tentatively scheduled to start in Summer 2020

Los Robles Avenue Lateral at Drumhill Drive, Copper Lantern Drive, and Deerhaven Drive – add new storm drain lateral and catch basins

Gale Avenue at Falstone Road – install traffic signal - construction is tentatively scheduled for early 2020.

Hacienda Boulevard at Shadybend Drive - Install Traffic Signal - construction is tentatively scheduled for early 2020.

Halliburton at Stimson - Installation of fully-protected left-turn phasing for eastbound and westbound traffic Fall 2019

Turnbull Canyon Rd at Vallecito Drive - Left Turn Pocket - Construction is tentatively scheduled for winter 2019

Dunswell Avenue from Gale Avenue to the end of cul-de-sac – installation of 9 streetlights on wood poles

Los Robles Avenue from Ridley Avenue to Coble Avenue – installation of 6 streetlights on wood poles

Kwis Avenue from Garo Street to Daykin Street – installation of 13 streetlights on wood poles

Kwis Avenue from Gale Avenue to Binney Street – installation of 9 streetlights on wood poles
