

HHIA 2021-22 Year-end report - St & Hwy (by Ted Chang, 2022.01.23)

As life goes on with Covid-19, people start going back to work place and schools, so comes back the traffic jams in LA county and accidents, especially during the holidays with more anxiety and less patience.

Hundreds died in L.A. traffic crashes in 2021 and many more were severely injured

Mayor Eric Garcetti's goal of ending traffic deaths by 2025, "Vision Zero" unveiled in 2015, looks increasingly unattainable following another year of rising fatalities and injuries caused by motorists.

According to LAPD data through Dec. 25, 289 people were killed in traffic collisions last year, 21% more than the same period in 2020 and 19% over the same period in 2019. A total of 1,465 people were severely injured, a 30% increase over the same period in 2020. The LAPD defines severely injured as needing to be transported from the collision.

The city's streets are increasingly dangerous for pedestrians in particular, with 486 being severely injured by motorists — a 35% increase over 2020. Pedestrian deaths rose 6% to 128.
