**TRAFFIC COLLISIONS**

- **2022 Traffic Collisions Year-to Date (YTD):**  
As of January 1, 2022, there are approximately **455** crashes reported.  
There was a total of **567** traffic collisions reported in 2021.
- **Monthly Traffic Collisions:**  
September 2022 a total of **54** traffic collisions compared to August of 2022 with a total of **50** traffic collisions. Traffic collisions **increased by 8%**.
- **September Collisions-to-date:**  
As of October 15, 2022, there has been **16** traffic collision reported (completed).

**TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS/ENFORCEMENT**

- We have received traffic complaints in the following area for the month of September.
  - Los Altos Drive and Frangancia Avenue for commercial vehicles (Tractor/Trailer combinations) parking in the area.
  - Gale Avenue from Hacienda Boulevard to Seventh Avenue for distracted drivers and speeding.
- Community Outreach and Programs Services (COPs) team and beat patrol units provided additional enforcement in the identified areas over **TWO** 8-hour deployments resulting in over **20+ citations issued** for commercial violations, speeding, and distracted driving.

**TRAFFIC SAFETY TIPS**

- **NATIONAL PEDESTRIAN SAFETY MONTH:**
  - Everyone is a Pedestrian:
    - We encourage and highlight the benefits of walking and mindfulness to wear something bright and visible. **ALWAYS** travel in the same direction as traffic. **ALWAYS** wear a helmet when you are riding or skating.
  - Safe speeds save lives:
    - Posted speed limits are not suggestions. As vehicular speed increases, so do the risk of death to pedestrians.
  - Halloween / Trick or Treat:
    - Use caution when traveling in residential areas during the holiday as families will be out and about enjoying the evening. Remind children not to dark into street and wear some form of reflective clothing items to be seen by motorists.
    - Explain to your children **NEVER** to accept candy (or any other items) from a stranger where the origin of the candy is unknown.

### COMMUNITY WORKSHOP/PRESENTATION HIGHLIGHT

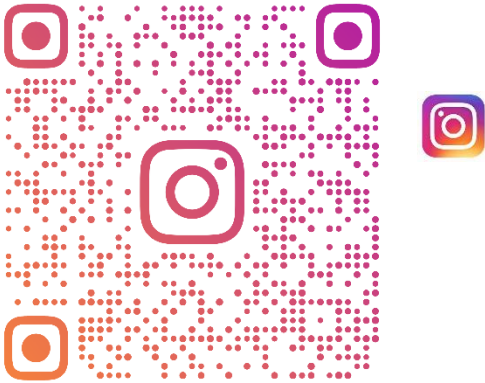
