TRAFFIC COLLISIONS

- **2023 Traffic Collisions Year-to Date (YTD):**
As of January 1, 2023, there are approximately **312** crashes reported.
There was a total of **596** traffic collisions reported in 2022.
- **Monthly Traffic Collisions:**
July 2023: There was a total of **47** traffic collisions compared to June of 2023 with a total of **33** traffic collisions. Traffic collisions **increased by 42%**.
- **Current Month Collisions-to-date:**
As of August 17, 2023, there have been **21** traffic collision reported (completed).

TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS/ENFORCEMENT

- Two complaints received on 07/05/2023 and 07/14/2023 regarding speeding and exhibition of speed on Turnbull Canyon Road.
 - Focused enforcement action is being taken along Turnbull Canyon Road. Results specific to evening hour patrols/enforcement resulted in over 100 enforcement stops on vehicles for multiple violations including speeding, distracted driving, modified exhaust and unsafe/illegal stopping.

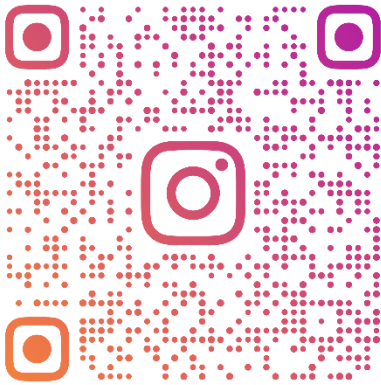
Impact Teen Drivers

Impact Teen Drivers (ITD) is a non-profit program focused on saving teen lives through education. The program is designed for attendance by teens with their parents. ITD provides education on the causes of collisions among teen drivers with a strong focus on distractions and risky driving behaviors behind the wheel as well as an explanation of the Graduated Driver License (GDL) requirements.

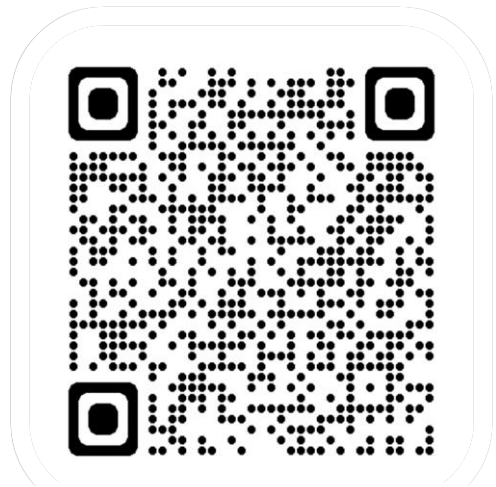
