TRAFFIC COLLISIONS

- 2022 Traffic Collisions Year-to Date (YTD):
As of January 1, 2022, there are approximately **592** crashes reported.
There was a total of **567** traffic collisions reported in 2021.
- Monthly Traffic Collisions:
December 2022 there was a total of **52** traffic collisions compared to October of 2022 with a total of **43** traffic collisions. Traffic collisions *increased by 20%*.
- Current Month Collisions-to-date:
As of January 18, 2023, there have been **16** traffic collision reported (completed).

During this holiday season, the CHP Santa Fe Springs Area participated in our annual CHiPs For Kids Toy Drive. As of today, December 19, 2022, we collected 12,115 toys and have given away 11,523 toys! We would like to thank the Hsi Lai Temple for their generous donation of over 8,000 toys this year!

CHP Santa Fe Springs Area had our inaugural Operation Jingle All the Way – Toy Give away this past Saturday, in which we served over 600 participants, with over 300 participants receiving a hot meal (provided by Applebee's) and gave away 1,100 toys!

CHP Santa Fe Springs Area have 4 new officers on patrol, having passed their on-the-job training! We are expecting another 6 trainee officers in their first month of training!

The Santa Fe Springs Area has three Officers assigned to our Community Outreach and Program Services unit. These Officers are on special assignment, and provide specific enforcement to our school zone areas, and traffic complaints as well as community activities which include parade details.

COMMUNITY WORKSHOP/PRESENTATION HIGHLIGHT

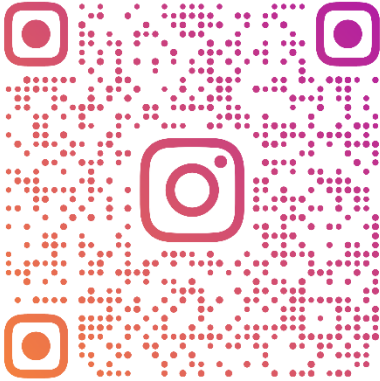
