GALE AVENUE AT FALSTONE AVENUE PROPOSED NEW TRAFFIC SIGNAL FACT SHEET

- **Background**

A constituent requested Public Works to evaluate the intersection of Gale Avenue at Falstone Avenue for additional traffic control devices. A study was conducted and installation of a new traffic signal was recommended based on Public Works' assessment of pedestrian volumes, field observations, and collision history.

- **Project Scope**

The objective of this project is to install a new traffic signal on Gale Avenue at Falstone Avenue.

- **Project Benefits**

When properly used, traffic signals are valuable devices for the control of vehicular and pedestrian traffic. They provide for the orderly movement of traffic and may reduce the frequency and severity of certain types of collisions.

- **Project Location**

The project is located at the intersection of Gale Avenue and Falstone Avenue in the unincorporated community of Hacienda Heights in Supervisorial District 4.

- **Community Outreach:**

A project information flyer and a pre-construction brochure will be provided shortly after the project has been awarded and a week prior to start of construction, respectively.

- **Cost Estimate**

Total Project: \$ 326,000

Construction: \$ 260,000

- **Economic Impact:** Project construction supports 3.2 direct and indirect jobs.
