

2021 Streets & Highways / Water & Utilities Annual Report

The Streets and Highway Committee monitors the current state of streets and highways soliciting information from residents, attending meetings, and maintaining relationships with LA County Government that maintain and improve all streets and highways. Maintain awareness of impending State and County projects and communicate information during HHIA meetings.

Due to the COVID Pandemic this year, this Chair was limited to being physically present in our community however; emails and concerns from our residents were heard and addressed by contacting representatives within LA Co. Public Works. This year HHIA did have a presentation on the “Garo St et al Project”. Additionally, a presentation was scheduled, however cancelled on an update of the Safe Street Vending Law and the pending ordinance.

This year I oversaw a second committee assignment, Water & Utilities Committee, as a representative of the HHIA organization, I would normally attend community events to promote and provide information about HHIA. The Water and Utilities Committee should monitor all aspects of LA County Utility Departments and Municipal Water Districts and was a conduit to members of HHIA. Towards the end of this year as the Chair I initiated contact with representatives for the Upper San Gabriel Valley Municipal Water District started to better understand what water supplies service Hacienda Heights and invited Patty Cortez, Director of Government and Community Affairs, to speak at a HHIA Board of Directors meeting. She has confirmed a presentation in the April 2021 meeting.
