SAFETY AND LAW ENFORCEMENT UPDATES:

CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL: Not present.

L.A. COUNTY TOWN SHERIFF: Brian Sanford reported that the recent double homicide was related to elder abuse. A recent rash of vandalism in the form of broken windows was reported, no arrests made. Burglaries are way down in the area with more resources available. There were two gang member arrests. The sheriffs are still targeting the trails. There is a safety seminar at the Community Center on October 29 6-8 pam.

MOUNTAINS RECREATION AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY: Mike Hughes reported citations for after-hour park infractions totaled 438 due to increased enforcement activities.
