Message from the Chair

As a longtime resident of Hacienda Heights and proud product of the HLPUSD school district Los Molinos Elementary, Newton Middle School, and Glen A. Wilson High School. I eventually moved away to pursue my dreams. I signed with Disney's Hollywood Records, toured the country opening for Britney Spears and the Backstreet Boys, starred in Model Behavior with Justin Timberlake, and appeared on ABC's Boy Meets World. I was honored to receive a Gold Record for two songs in The Princess Diaries movie and soundtrack.

After years spent on tour buses, red carpets, and living in Los Angeles, Hacienda Heights was always home. My parents and some of my siblings still live here, and this community has always held my heart. "No matter where life has taken me, **Hacienda Heights** has always been home."

I've participated in the *July 4th parade* many times over its 37-year history, and it broke my heart to see this beloved tradition the one and only community-wide event in our unincorporated town start to fade away. Yes, the pandemic disrupted everything, but we still found ways to do the parade. In 2024, I made a personal vow: I'm going to step up, get involved, and make sure .this tradition doesn't get left behind.

At the start of 2025, I met with longtime parade organizers who warned me: it wouldn't be easy. But I'm not someone who backs down. They gave me their blessing, and in March just three months ago I said, Let's do this.

I went door to door, introducing myself to mom and pop businesses, car dealerships, and major companies in the area. I made countless phone calls, and yes, I hit some resistance **but 90%** of the people I met with were thrilled that someone was finally bringing it back, even in a new form.

A full parade wasn't possible this year. Due to new state laws and county policy, the CHP now charges over \$18,000 just to close half a mile of road something that used to be free for over 30 years. Longtime groups like the Kiwanis who used to grill hot dogs were suddenly being asked to provide permits, sinks, and meet new health code requirements from LA County Parks. Understandably, many said, No way.

And when I say we started with **zero** money, I'm not exaggerating there wasn't a single penny on the books when I began at the end of March.

I am deeply grateful to the sponsors who said **YES** and the churches, businesses, and community groups who reached out with: "How can we help? What do you need?" That's the Hacienda Heights I know a community that shows up, full of culture, heart, and pride.

This year's celebration reflects all of us a tapestry of voices, faces, and traditions coming together to celebrate not just the place we call home, but the nation we live in.

I'm determined to bring the full parade back in **2026** but we'll need to raise a heck of a lot of money to make it happen. So, HLPUSD band teachers don't take your vacations over July 4th! We want to hear those marching bands echoing all the way to the 60 Freeway!

Thank you to everyone who came out to celebrate the revival of this tradition. Thank you for showing up, for saying yes, and for keeping the spirit of our town alive. Spread the word to your family, friends, and neighbors and we'll see you next year, bigger, louder, and prouder than ever.
