TRAFFIC COLLISIONS

- **2023 Traffic Collisions Year-to Date (YTD):**
As of January 1, 2023, there are approximately **435** crashes reported.
There was a total of **596** traffic collisions reported in 2022.
- **Monthly Traffic Collisions:**
October 2023: There was a total of **37** traffic collisions compared to September of 2023 with a total of **35** traffic collisions. Traffic collisions *increased by 5%*.
- **Current Month Collisions-to-date:**
As of November 20, 2023, there have been **15** traffic collision reported (completed).

TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS/ENFORCEMENT

- Turnbull Canyon Road and Skyline: complaints regarding street racing and loud exhaust during the hours of 9:00pm to 2:00am.
 - Additional enforcement has taken place resulting in approximately 25 citations being issued, one DUI arrest, one vehicle impounded, and numerous verbal warnings.
 - Patrol units are aware of the ongoing issue.

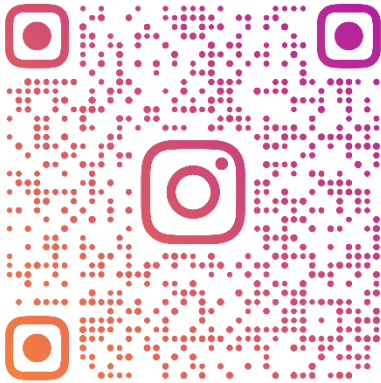
Right Turn
