Dog Park Update

For many years our Hacienda Heights residents have voiced their desire for a dog park in our neighborhood. The Hacienda Heights Improvement Association has discussed the potential of having a dog park and set a goal to investigate this project. 4th District Supervisor Janice Hahn recently shared the news that the Board of Supervisors have approved a plan to construct a space at Schabarum Park for dogs to safely play off-leash. It will have separate areas for large and small dogs and drinking fountains for humans and canines. More details soon.

Project Description: The dog park is a $\frac{3}{4}$ acre off-leash dog park with two fenced in areas (one area for large and a separate area for small dogs.) There will be a seated area with shade covering and landscaping. The dog park will be near the entrance of the park (northwest corner near Azusa)

Cost: The Supervisor is covering the cost of the project, which in total is \$1.4 million.

Timeline: The project is scheduled to begin February 2021 and is expected to take 9 months to complete. HHIA is invited to join in the ribbon cutting once it's open!

HHIA Contribution: HHIA is offering to donate a fountain with a plaque. This is still in the planning stages.
